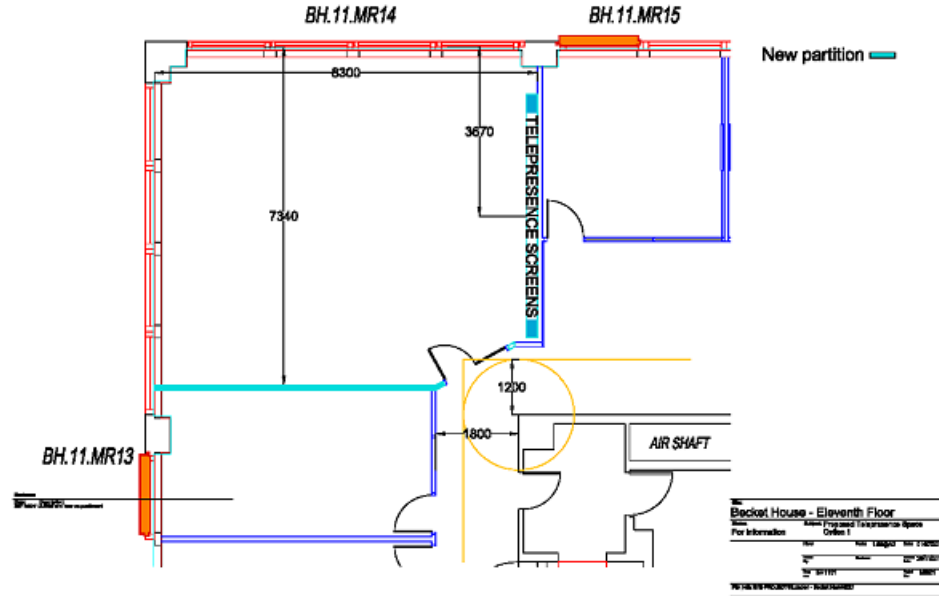
- Relocation of walls to enable a larger room square meter foot print.
